Arrival

Proceed to immigration clearance

Take an on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test

During SHN

May subject to electronic monitoring or physical spot-checks

Adhere to SHN requirements and restrictions at all times

Take COVID-19 PCR test at the end of SHN/ assigned slot



Quarantine

Employees may subject to different quarantine conditions depends on departing country

- Exemption of SHN if tested negative
- 7-days SHN at self-sourced accommodation/ place of residency
- 14-days SHN at SHN dedicated facility (<u>opt-out available</u>)
- 14-days SHN at SHN dedicated facility
- 14-days SHN at SHN dedicated facility + 7-days SHN at place of residency

Quarantine

Employees may subject to different quarantine conditions depends on departing country

- 7-days SHN at self-sourced accommodation/ place of residency
- 14-days SHN at SHN dedicated facility
- 14-days SHN at SHN dedicated facility + 7-days SHN at place of residency

What if my employee(s) was recently diagnosed with COVID-19 infection in overseas?

When can my employee(s) enter Singapore again?

You should schedule the employee(s)' travel into Singapore at least 21 days after his/her date of COVID-19 diagnosis, based on his/her first positive PCR test.

Example:



Depart back to Singapore

My employee(s) has recovered from COVID-19, however, he/she is still tested positive on PCR test within 72 hours prior departure, can my employee(s) enter Singapore?

If he/she is still tested positive, recovered individuals must also submit documentary proof of his/her past diagnosis of COVID-19 with following details/ requirements:

- First ever positive PCR test result in English with the date of test ۰
- Date of the first ever positive PCR test result must be between 22 to 180 days prior to the date of arrival in Singapore.
- Traveller's identification details clearly stated in the test results

Vietnam

The regulations below only applicable for permitted visitors on trips with less than 14 days









Prepare travel itinerary and submit application to HCMC's Department of Labour/ Invalids and social affairs/ Hanoi's People Committee

Maximum stay: 14 days Submit online health declaration at https://tokhaiyte.vn/

Negative PCR COVID-19 test 3 to 5 days prior to departure

Ensure the traveller(s) is covered with appropriate health insurance; or investing agencies/ organisations to bear any treatment fee related to COVID-19 Present negative COVID-19 PCR results

Must install and register with Bluezone application Mandatory COVID-19 swab tests every two days while in Vietnam in lieu of quarantine
