The answer of the officer sought to be recalled is as follows: I am the first Pacific Islander ever elected to office in San Francisco, giving my marginalized community a voice in local government for the first time. During my two years on the Board, I authored substantive legislation that will increase teacher retention through the construction of teacher housing. I also authored legislation regarding transportation and Medi-Cal services that will save San Francisco Unified School District over 20 million dollars and improve services to students and families tremendously. COVID-19 has created a volatile situation, exposing aging structures as unhealthy work environments, and causing fiscal difficulty. Through painstaking planning we addressed the facilities challenges, and with the development of vaccines and federal stimulus dollars SFUSD will emerge from this pandemic on solid footing.
