### MARCAP UNVEILS NEXT GENERATION VESSEL

On the 30<sup>th</sup> of December 2018, Marcap's new DP2 Platform Supply Vessel "Marcap Supporter" went On-Hire as she commenced her 03 years charter with ADNOC Offshore.

Marcap Supporter is the latest addition to Marcap's fleet.



Similar to the year 2003 where there was a fleet revamp with the acquisition of newer and higher technological vessels, the company has started strategizing in 2018 for the next 15 years, as it prepares for the growth and challenges ahead.

Built in 2018, the KC design PSV stands out from most PSVs as she is 60m in length with deadweight of 1,721T. Unlike most PSVs of the 3,000 DWT and above category, the Marcap Supporter is unique and ideal for the operations in UAE waters, where the field is relatively closer in proximity to shore.

Propelled by 02 Azimuth Propellers and powered by 4,000 PS Niigata engines, this also relates to greater fuel efficiency for PSV of her class.

In addition, Marcap Supporter has generous cargo carrying capacity, and with deck area of 418 m² which is bigger than most OSVs in the 60m LOA category. Her additional features include recovery oil tanks, where the vessel has an option of upgrading to cover Oil Spill Recovery.

As a DP2 PSV, she is equipped with 04 reference systems, encompassing 02 DGPS, 01 CyScan, and 01 Radius. The Marcap Supporter is also able to accommodate 50 persons on board.



The event commenced at 1600hrs and showcased the hidden talents in Marcap.


Away from the competitive at heart, there was another segment where the pace was relatively more relaxed as family members gathered together to join in the fun.
