Early Childhood Early Intervention Program (ECEI)



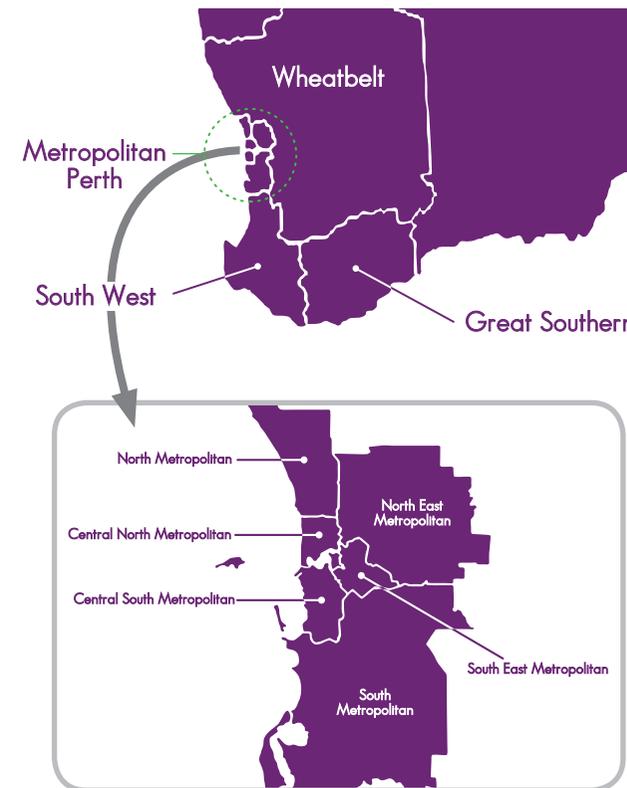
It is important to support children with a developmental delay or disability as early as possible.

### How does it work?

Wanslea's ECEI Practitioners are trained professionals in early childhood development. They will work closely with you to understand the needs of your child and family.

The ECEI Practitioner will provide helpful information, connect you and your child with the most appropriate supports in your area, and they may also provide some short-term early intervention supports. Where your child may require longer term intervention supports, the ECEI Practitioner will assist you with requesting access to the NDIS.

The ECEI Practitioner will meet with you and your child in your home, within the community, at the local Wanslea office, or at an alternative and convenient location.
