1. Information about our use of Cookies

this policy. If you do not agree to such use, please refrain from using the Website. Cookies cannot retrieve information from your device which tells us about you or your family and, unless you have logged in to a secure part of the site, cookies cannot be used to identify who you are.

Cookies will not be used to contact you for any sales or marketing purposes.

3. Use of Cookies

To help you understand the types of cookies we use (or those which may be used by third parties on our site), we have categorised the cookies in relation to their functionality:

- 2. Analytical/Performance Cookies
- 3. Functionality Cookies
- 4. Targeting Cookies
- 5. Advertising Cookies

Strictly Necessary Cookies

Strictly Necessary Cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the Website and use its features or they are cookies that are required to comply with laws. Without these cookies, services you have asked for cannot be provided.

These cookies do not gather any information that could be used for marketing to you or remember your preferences/ID, other than for your current session.

Analytical/Performance Cookies

Analytical/Performance Cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our Website(s) and to see how these visitors move around/interact with our Website(s). We may, for example, use analytical cookies to provide data on how many users have visited our site, how long users have spent on the site, and what buttons they have clicked. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

These cookies do not collect any information that could identify you. All the information collected is anonymous. They will not be used to target adverts to you on other websites.

Functionality Cookies

Functionality Cookies are used to recognize you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalize our content for you, and remember your preferences. These cookies are essential for our Website to function properly.

We will not use Functionality Cookies to target you with adverts on other websites.

As the name suggests, if you choose not to allow these cookies, the functionality of this Website may be affected. It is also possible that by not permitting these cookies, our Website will not be able to remember some of the specific services you have chosen.

Targeting Cookies

Targeting Cookies collect information about your browsing habits to deliver adverts which are more relevant to you and your interests. They also measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

Advertising Cookies

Advertising Cookies allow us to target our advertising to you or to people similar to you, or to exclude you from our advertising. Or a third party advertising cookie may be used by our advertising partners to create audiences on our behalf enabling us to target our advertising spend more efficiently.
