### Discussion Questions

1. In this passage from Luke 10, Jesus describes three men who pass by the battered man on the side of the road. Ross points out that two of the men pass by to maintain their righteousness. In what ways do you think we do the same today? Explain.
2. Consider the third man, the Samaritan. What do you think it means to show mercy?
3. Ross says we are most like the man who has been robbed and beaten. Why do you think Ross makes that parallel? In what ways have you experienced this to be true?
4. How does viewing Jesus in the role of the Samaritan inform your acts of mercy toward others?
5. Who is God asking you to see with compassion? How will you respond in obedience?
