1. Describe a time that you followed someone that got you lost or in a predicament. How important is it that the person we follow or look to be trustworthy and competent?
2. What was the role of the king according to **Deuteronomy 17:14-20**? What was the king supposed to be careful to avoid? How are these criteria different than the criteria of the president of the United States?
3. What role was the Word of God to have in the king's life in **verses 18-20**? How does that reveal the importance of the Word of God in our lives?
4. What was God's promise to David in **2 Samuel 7:8-13**? What did David do to deserve this promise?
5. How does this compare to Adam, Abraham, Noah, Israel? What were their lives like before God made a covenant with them? What was your life like before you knew Jesus?
6. Adam failed as the first man, the king of creation, who was to reflect God's image and God's reign. We fail as well. How does the promise of an eternal kingdom give hope to what was lost in Eden?
7. What impact did the enemy have in the garden of Eden? What was the promise given in **Genesis 3:15**? What will happen to the enemies through this kingdom that would occur from the offspring of David (**vs. 10-11**)?
8. How certain can we be of this particular promise of God according to **Psalms 89:35-37**? What is a truth that we can depend upon when we look at the moon or sun?
9. If you were a Jew living in the times before Jesus, what would you expect this king to do when he shows up? How did Jesus go against their expectations? Do you think Jesus continues to go outside of expectations today?
10. When we put our trust in Jesus as our Savior, we become citizens of His kingdom. What does it look like for Jesus to be the king of our lives? Why can we trust Jesus in a way that we can trust no one else?
