Karla Pappon ball court – the school would like to renew the covered court and outdoor area to the side/back of the sports hall, in memorial of Karla Pappon. We haven't received any information yet regarding costs, but it looks likely to be a large project requiring a lot of funding. The officers are in communication with the school and will report back once they have more detailed information.

Beautiful school project – the school have requested around £2k to pay for the cost of special displays in public areas to showcase pupil's work and achievements. The officers are waiting for more information and will update once they have it.

The allocated area for this planned space has changed since the original bid for council funding, but the council have confirmed that funding can still be given for the new area/plans (where old PE equipment is currently situated, next to the covered Striding Man statue). Project is ongoing.
