## ABOUT US

The Classical Academies is an organization of award-winning, tuition-free, California public charter schools serving North San Diego County since 1999. The Classical Academies offer a flexible, personalized educational environment that blends the best of independent study and the traditional classroom experience. These hybrid programs are uniquely designed to encourage students to explore their interests, accommodate their learning style, and reach their maximum potential of becoming thinkers, communicators, and achievers.

At Classical Academy Vista, class sizes are small, students are known by name, and parents are invited to participate in all educational and social activities. The mission of The Classical Academies is to partner with parents to inspire students to think critically, communicate effectively, and achieve excellence by providing academic choice.

## TRACK A & B

Students in grades K-8 meet on campus on Tuesdays and Wednesdays (Track A) or Thursdays and Fridays (Track B) from 9:00 am - 3:30 pm. Students in grades K-8 meet on campus on Tuesdays and Wednesdays (Track A) or Thursdays and Fridays (Track B) from 9:00 am - 3:30 pm. Students in grades 7-8 have the option of attending school on Mondays to receive additional core instruction. Workshops are limited to 20 students per teacher. Students have a traditional school day with recess and lunch breaks. While on campus, students work on core subject areas along with elective classes. Electives focus on the arts or technology. On non-workshop days, a parent or guardian facilitates learning at home.

## TRACK C

Track C is a full-time, five-day independent study option that is directed by a parent or guardian. Learning is accomplished at home and optional lesson plans and curriculum are supplied by The Classical Academies. Track C allows greater flexibility with curriculum selection. Each family is assigned an Educational Specialist who serves as a resource and advocate. Students conference with their Educational Specialist every six weeks to review learning objectives and present work samples. Grades TK through 8 will also have optional instructional classes available on Mondays.

Throughout the year there are many field trips and clubs for students to participate in that encourage friendships and build community.

## ONLINE (TRACK C)

Families who utilize the independent study program have additional options for learning online. Students in grades 3-8 can access their lesson plans and instruction online, greatly assisting with planning and grading.

## VIRTUAL PROGRAM (TRACK C)

Families who utilize the independent study program for grades 1-8 may also participate in virtual distance learning classes two to three times per week. Students attend class virtually with a credentialed teacher.
