ABOUT US

The Classical Academies are an organization of award-winning, tuition-free, California public charter schools serving North San Diego County since 1999. Classical Academy Middle School incorporates rigorous academics with a well-rounded middle school experience. There are two programs to choose from: Summit Learning and M Track. Both programs offer classes on campus Tuesday through Thursday while providing personalized learning options for students to achieve mastery of the standards. In both programs, students are able to participate in elective courses and activities including art, coding, band, engineering, drawing, newspaper, yearbook, and more.

ASSESSMENTS

The Classical Academies use a variety of assessments to track understanding, monitor progress, and celebrate accomplishments. Assessments include the use of unit tests and skill-based and performance-based assessments. We monitor annual personal growth using Renaissance Star Assessments © and California State Performance Assessments with the goal of student mastery, understanding, and success.

M TRACK

Students enrolled in M Track attend class on campus Tuesday-Thursday from 8:25 am-3:15 pm. During the school day, students attend classes in core subjects including math, science, English, writing, and history. Curriculum and instruction is accessed through Schoology (our online learning management system), using both online e-textbooks and physical textbooks.

Credentialed teachers specialize in middle school instruction and are passionate about hands-on activities, collaborative learning, and real-life applications while integrating technology. Students complete assignments at home on Mondays and Fridays with the support of their parent or guardian.



SUMMIT LEARNING

Students enrolled in the Summit Learning program attend class on campus Tuesday-Thursday from 8:25 am-3:15 pm and complete work at home with the support of their parent or guardian on Mondays and Fridays. This program teaches students to become self-directed learners who develop lifelong skills.

As a Summit Learning Partner, we use a comprehensive curriculum created by Summit Learning's Curriculum & Assessment team, and modified by Classical Academy teachers. Each course is made up of teacher-led projects, and independent study focus areas. Summit Learning utilizes three unique elements: projects, self-directed learning, and mentoring; which include goal setting, habits of success, character development, motivation, and self-advocacy.
