*If not completing the video + activity, ask an ice breaker question like "What is one place you went this week?"

SAY: The Epistles help us everyday as we put the Good News in action! Paul wrote many of the Epistles.

ASK: What is another word for an Epistle?

ANSWER: Letter

ASK: How many of Paul's letters are in the

New Testament?

ANSWER: 13

SAY: In the video, we learned about 3 words: Justified, Grace & Faith. Let's review that last word, "faith." To have faith in God is to believe He is who He says He is and that He'll do what He says He'll do.

ASK: Can you think of a time when your faith in God helped you do something hard or a little bit scary?
