Sho = true or truthful  
Shin = heart  
Ryu = tradition, school

*Truthful Heart* – Shoshin Ryu is the tradition or school of the Truthful Heart. How is that translation interpreted? Students of Shoshin Ryu learn to speak from a voice that is representative of one body, one mind; from a unified presence that is an honest reflection of self. Truthful heart means you train to be sincere, that you strive to be honest with yourself and others. Sincerity does not mean that you are perfect or right in everything you do; but that even when you make mistakes, your heart was in the right place. A truthful, sincere heart strives to do the right thing and corrects the behavior when it is not. This is being truthful with one's self. You know where you are and you also know what you are capable of becoming.

If for instance, you yell out and curse because that is what you really feel. You can tell yourself that you are just being honest. That is a farce. The truth is you are angry and you are reacting to that anger. A truthful heart means recognizing the anger inside and working to solve the root of that anger.
