Fr. Michael's Message The Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The short space of time between Christmas and Lent quickly draws to a close. During this "ordinary" time we have been hearing from Jesus about the call to follow Him as a disciple. In the Sermon on the Mount Jesus has preached the Beatitudes, the call to be "salt and light" for the earth, and today the radical call to holiness. Jesus wants His followers to have not just a transformation of actions, but a transformation of their desires, a transformation of the heart. In preaching this radical holiness, Jesus is not giving us an unattainable goal: He is inviting us into His own life of holiness.

Here at Saint Dominic we have a full slate of activities for all ages: sacramental preparation for kids and adults, Catholic Student Ministry, our upcoming mission trip to Peru, Young Disciples and Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Confirmation prep, Catechism in a Year discussion group, as well as Rosary and prayer groups meeting throughout the week. All this without the benefit of a stable building to meet in. For these reasons we should be excited about the progress of the Monsignor Crowe Community Center and I ask and encourage you to make a pledge, increase your pledge if possible, and to consider making a memorial gift towards this project. 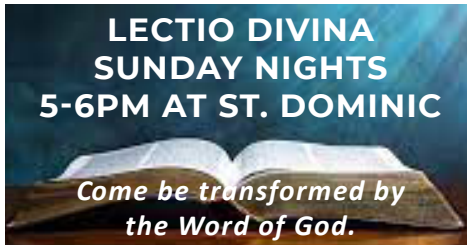
