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


Overall Health Factors





Figure 5 – Ethnicity


Figure 16 - Leading Causes of Death





Assault-Related Crude Death Rates by Firearm






Age-Adjusted Death Rates for Firearm Assault










Assault-Related Death by Race






Assault-Related Death by Gender






Assault-Related Death by Race and Gender






Assault-Related Death by Education Level






Assault-Related Death by Marital Status










Social Vulnerability Index

- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention SVI score of ≥ .75


