Policies & Guidelines

Be sure to leave a message or send us a text if you reach our voicemail with your name, your child's name, and a phone number we can reach you.

Registration: A non-refundable annual registration fee is due per dancer to secure each participant's position in our

program. *Individual Annual Registration: \$35 *Family Annual Registration (2 or more siblings): \$65

<u>Tuition Breakdown</u>

Monthly Tuition (per student) Breakdown for Multiple Class Discount (per enrolled dancer):

\$65/month (1 class each week) \$65 per month 1st class | \$60 per month 2nd class (must be same dancer)

\$125/month (2 classes each week) \$55 per month 3rd class (must be same dancer)

\$180/month (3 classes each week) \$50 per month 4th class (and each additional class for the same dancer)

\$230/month (4 classes each week)

\$280/month (5 classes each week) \$125 per month for a class that meets for 1 hour, twice a week

\$330/month (6 classes each week) \$230 per month for a class that meets for 2 hours, twice a week

Payment Policy

- * Your first tuition installment payment is due per class per dancer at the time of registration to secure each dancer's position in each class.
- ❖ Tuition is due on the 25th of each month beginning July 25 (for August) through April 25 (for May). Tuition is a yearly amount divided into 10 equal payments.
- ♦ Dance Quest strongly encourages all families to enroll in our Recurring Payment System. This option is available in the "Payment Info" section during your ONLINE registration process. It is your responsibility to keep your credit card info updated and follow your account online. Enroll in the Auto/Recurring payment system and receive a 5% discount* on your monthly tuition (per child/per class)!! *discount applies to Recreational classes ONLY. Discount may not be applied to any other group rate, including but not limited to Company Team Tuition.
- ❖ Monthly tuition WILL NOT be prorated. It will always remain the same regardless of holidays or the number of weeks in each month.
- ❖ Tuition fees are to be paid monthly and ON TIME!!! A \$15 late fee will be applied to your account on the 1st of the month.
- Any non-payment after the 10th of the month may result in the automatic removal of your dancer from our roster. Full month tuition and the \$15.00 late fee will be required to reinstate the dancer's placement in class(es). It is your obligation to contact us if there are extenuating circumstances.

Return Checks: NSF on paper checks, auto-debit, or auto-charge payments will incur a \$35 NSF fee and must be resolved within 10 days of receiving NSF notice.

<u>Withdrawal Procedure:</u> If withdrawal from any/all class(es) is necessary, Dance Quest International, Inc. requires 30-Days written notice. The withdrawal notice must be received by the 25th of the month. You will be responsible for the next full month tuition installment. Tuition sessions are broken into monthly installments, tuition is not prorated. Tuition is non-refundable. Costume deposits are non-refundable. All open balances must be paid prior to the final date. By withdrawing, should you wish to re-enroll during this season, a registration fee is required. *** If wishing to transfer classes, please have the class instructor or a member of the Dance Quest International team complete the transfer request form.

<u>Costume/Recital Fees:</u> Dance Quest will assume that each registered student will be performing in the June 2022 Recital. Upon registration, a costume fee of \$120 (per dance class) will be applied to your account for each class that your child is taking. A \$45 Recital Fee* will be applied for each student. *Recital Fee includes a digital download of all your dancer's recital performance photos!

For your convenience, this will be divided into three payments:

\$75 Non-refundable Costume Deposit (per class) due by September 25. LATE FEE will be applied on October 1.

\$45 Costume/recital installment Balance (per class) due by January 25. LATE FEE will be applied on February 1.

\$45 Recital Fee (per student) due by April 25. LATE FEE applied on May 1.

- ❖ You are responsible for paying the SPECIFIED AMOUNTS BY THE DUE DATES!!! Avoid late fees... pay on time!!!
- As an added convenience, our system will allow you to pay any amount towards your fees prior to the due dates to accommodate your budget.
- Costume(s) are required for your dancer to participate in our RECITAL PERFORMANCE.
- ♦ Costumes take 8-16 weeks to produce. Costume orders must be placed **BEFORE Christmas Break**, therefore, your \$75 NON-REFUNDABLE costume deposit must be collected **NO LATER October 1**.

<u>Attendance:</u> Dance Quest International, Inc. honors most major holidays. The monthly fees have been set using the county school calendar as a guide. Therefore, there is no absentee credit for these days. When a participant is absent from his/her class(es) we cannot reschedule a make-up class. Please contact us for any extended absenteeism (Illness/Injury). A doctor's note is required for monthly tuition to be pro-rated for classes that need to be dropped due to medical reasons.

<u>Class Cancellations due to Weather or other natural disaster:</u> Dance Quest International, Inc. DOES NOT make-up classes due to acts of God (Hurricanes, Tornadoes, global pandemic, ETC.) Though we will check with local school districts, it will be at the discretion of the directors that we close the studio or cancel classes. We will send updates via email and social media in the event of a closing or late start due to weather related issues. Please follow us on Facebook & Instagram.

<u>Credits/Refunds:</u> Credit may be issued when a schedule change is initiated. Credits may be applied to any Dance Quest Class tuition and must be redeemed within one (1) year. Refunds are issued only when you are unable to find a suitable replacement class when Dance Quest International cancels a class due to low enrollment. A class minimum of eight (8) must be reached.

STUDIO RULES:

- ★ Respectful behavior towards your teachers and your fellow students is expected at all times. We want everyone to treat each other with complete respect and love.
- \star No candy or gum chewing in any class.
- ★ Hair must be secured up off your neck and away from your face in all classes. Hair must be secured into a proper, clean, bun for all Ballet Classes. Please bring your own supply of hairbands and bobby pins.
- ★ Jewelry should not be worn to dance class. Stud earrings are acceptable.
- \star No one is allowed in class other than dancers.
- ★ Only water bottles are allowed in the studio/classrooms. Please be certain that your name is labeled on your water bottle! All other food and beverage items must be kept in the lobby area. Please bring your own supply of spoons and forks.
- ★ NO cell phones may be brought into the studio/classrooms by students and all cell phones must be turned down in the cafe/lobby area so as to not distract from classes.
- ★ Please use the restroom before class.
- ★ Shoes and proper dance attire is required. (Reference our DQ Dress Code)
- ★ Please clean up after yourself in the classroom/studio, lobby, and patio.
- ★ Always supervise young children and please clean up all messes left by your children or family.
- ★ No foul language or gossip of any sort is permitted at any time at Dance Quest International, Inc.
- \star Label your items so your belongings will not get lost in the shuffle.
- ★ Please keep toys, bags, shoes, and other obstructions off the floor to prevent injury to others.
- ★ Dancers are to be picked up promptly following classes and at no time will be allowed to leave the facility to go shopping in the area without a parent or guardian or permission from a parent/guardian.
- ★ IF you have any questions or concerns, please discuss them with the management team or instructors when it does not interfere with classes. We are always interested in improving our dance education programs and every suggestion will be taken into consideration. ★ Parents should call the studio ahead of class time to let us know if a student will not be in class.

Dance Quest is committed and strives to provide excellence in dance education in an atmosphere of encouragement. We want to maintain a clean, friendly, family-orientated environment. The policies and rules are to ensure that all dancers get the dance education that they deserve. We hope you enjoy your Dance Quest experience and look forward to a fun and exciting dance year!

Dance Quest Dancewear Requirements

At Dance Quest International, proper dance attire must be worn at all times. DQI maintains a dress code to encourage concentration and a sense of inclusiveness. Uniformity in dancewear allows the teachers to assess how well the students are implementing technique being taught, problems with alignment and other important aspects of dance training. We understand that a student may start class with different attire and shoes and move towards the requirements as new shoes and attire are purchased.

Students' hair must be neat and in place, pulled back off of their face and neck. In Ballet, a bun is required at all times. Loose hair is an impediment while dancing and is a distraction to the dancer during class. When hair is secured properly, it allows the student to completely focus on their dancing. No jewelry (except for small earrings) is to be worn to class or rehearsals. The appropriate dance shoes must be worn in class. Dance shoes should never be worn outside.
